Note: all seam allowances are 1/4" unless other wise stated


| Cutting Instructions | <u> </u> | | 6" | 12" |
|----------------------|--------------------------|----------------------|---|---|
| Background | Cut Cut Cut Cut | 3 1 * 2 1 * | 2 ½" squares 2 3/8 th " squares 2" x 3 ½" rectangles 3 7/8 th square | 4" squares 3 7/8 th " squares 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles 6 7/8 th " square |
| Fabric A,B,C | Cut | 1 each | 2 ½"squares | 4" squares |
| Fabric D | Cut Cut | 1 * 1 * | 2 3/8th" squares 3 7/8th" square | 3 7/8 th " squares 6 7/8 th " square |

* cut in half diagonally once

Piecing Instructions

Drawn a diagonal line on the back of the Background 2 ¹/₂" (4") squares. Pair up a 2 ¹/₂" (4") Fabric A square – right sides together and sew ¹/₄" on either side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press. Repeat this step with the Fabric B & C squares. Trim each half square triangle block to 2" (3 ¹/₂").


Take one of the 2" (3 ½") half square triangles and sew a Background 2 3/8th" (3 7/8th) half to either side as shown. You will sew one on, fold back and press and then sew the second one. * you will have a ¼" overlap at this point.



3. Sew a Fabric D 2 3/8th" (37/8th) half square triangle to the end of the Background 2" x 3 ½" (3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle) Repeat this step with the remaining background rectangle but this time the half square triangle is on the other end as shown.

Okey dokey, time to put your block together. Lay out all your block pieces as shown below and piece in the order shown.

Note: You will only use half of the **Fabric D and Background** 3 7/8th (6 7/8th") square. The other half will be for another project.



Well done, another gorgeous block make. Press well and your block will measure 6 ½" (12 ½")

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
