Note: all seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless other wise stated


Cutting Instructions - use dark mediums and lights for this block

|  |  | $6 "$ | $12^{\prime \prime}$ |  |
| :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Fabric A | 1 | 5" square | 1 | 9" square |
| Fabric B (light) | 1 | 5" square | 1 | 9" square |
| Fabric C | 10 | 2" squares | 4 | 3" squares |
| Fabric D (light) | 10 | 2" squares | 4 | $3 "$ squares |

## Putting It All Together

1. Cut the Fabric A \& Fabric B $5^{\prime \prime}\left(9^{\prime \prime}\right)$ in half diagonally. You will only use one half of each fabric for this block.
2. With right sides together sew the two together along the diagonal edge. Open out and press to the dark fabric. Trim back to $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}\left(8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ square.

3. Making Half Square Triangle Blocks

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric D 2" ( 3") squares.
Pair each one together with a Fabric C $2^{\prime \prime}\left(3^{\prime \prime}\right)$ square. Sew together $14^{\prime \prime}$ either side of the diagonal line.

Cut apart on the diagonal line - open out and press to the dark fabric. Trim each square back to $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " ( $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ ). You will have 20 half square triangle units.


Sew you half square triangles into two groups of four and two groups of six. Take care to orientate them the same way as shown below.

Now you have all your units make, it's time to put your block together.
