## Cutting Instructions

Darks

Lights

## 6"

$1 \quad 21 / 2$ ", square
$2 \quad 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
$2 \quad 2^{1 / 2 " \prime}$ square
2 3 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## $12 "$

$\begin{array}{ll}4 & 21 / 2 " \text { squares } \\ 8 & 31 / 2 " \text { squares }\end{array}$
$16 \quad 21 / 2$ " squares
$8 \quad 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## Piecing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Light $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares
2. Place a Dark and a Light $31 / 2$ " square, right sides together. Making sure all sides are even, pin in the middle. Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on either side of the diagonal drawn line. Cut apart on the line and press to the dark.
3. Trim back to $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make 4 (16) half square triangle units.

Lay out your block as shown below and piece together in rows as shown, taking care to butt your seams.

Block Layout


Make one unit for your 6" block.
Make four units and sew together as shown below to make your 12" block.

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
